

- Student School Supplies The school has purchased school supplies for all students, the charge for school supplies by grade can be found in the school charges document below and is listed at the bottom of the Tiger News. All students will need a pair of inside shoes.
- Regular family communication will be sent each week, via this newsletter. The newsletter is a live link, so it can be bookmarked. It will be updated each weekend and emailed out at the start of each week. Regular updates will also be posted on our website and school Facebook page. If families have questions they can contact the school by phone or email. Responses on Facebook will be limited, please reference the newsletter and call or email the school.
- **First Day** We are finalizing plans for the first day of school. Details about the first day process will be emailed out by the end of the week. Class lists will be draft for the first week of school, due the timing of new registrations and student/family movement.
- **Taylor School Routines and Processes** We are working on a slideshow for families that will be shared out next week with all our school routines and processes. As we settle into the school year, we will continue to update and share with families. A few routines have been listed below:
  - Morning and after school supervision Students can be dropped off no earlier than 8:30 am and there is no after school supervision with the exception of late bus students. Students are welcome to stay on the playground after school with parent supervision.
  - Visitors are welcome, but all visitors must check in at the office and wear a mask.
  - We will be asking families and community visitors to enter via the playground doors and district staff to enter via the parking lot door. The visitor sign-in will be at the office.
  - End of the day student pick-up will be outside.
  - Appointments will need to be made to set up meetings with teachers or the principal. Please call the school or email to set up meetings.
  - o Please send a lunch that does not need to be heated, microwaves will not be available in classrooms for student use.
