

Communication October 4-8

- Communication from Superintendent regarding the New Provincial K-3 Masking mandate:
 - Dear Parents,
 The provincial health officer along with the Ministry of Education announced a change to mask requirements in K-12 schools. Effective Monday,
 October 4th, mandatory face masks will now be extended to include students in K-3 in school and on buses. Further information on the update
 can be found here. We ask that you send your K-3 child with the appropriately-sized mask next week but we understand that it may take some
 time to procure them. The School District is also working on sourcing a supply. All children will be welcomed regardless of whether or not they
 are wearing a mask. As with the other grades, it is also possible to request an exemption. Schools remain one of the safest environments during
 this pandemic and it is critical that education continues uninterrupted for students and families. Thank you for your understanding as we continue
 to work through this pandemic together.
- COVID-19 Exposure Notification Process The notification process has recently changed. In the event of a potential school exposure, Northern Health will be posting information on their website at https://www.northernhealth.ca/health-topics/public-exposures-and-outbreaks#covid-19-school-exposures General letters to the entire school will be replaced by the website notifications similar to what occurred during winter and spring breaks last year. Letters may be sent home to select close contacts as determined by Northern Health. For example a letter may be sent to a specific classroom and the notice posted on the NH website.
- **School Photo Day** is Monday, October 4th, there are no pre-order forms, following photo day, each student will receive a code and families will be able to order photos online. **Photo retake day is October 27th.**
- **Open House** We will be hosting an Open house on Wednesday, October 6th between 6:00 and 7:00 pm. We will also be sharing a slideshow so that families can meet all our staff in a virtual manner. The Open House is an opportunity to see your child's classroom and meet their teacher. The following guidelines will be in place:
 - o Only students of Taylor School and their parents/guardians can attend (no younger or older siblings that don't attend Taylor School).
 - o Families will enter via the playground doors.
 - o All visitors must follow the visitor guidelines:
 - complete a daily health check, sign-in, wear a mask and sanitize/wash hands. See the visitor poster at the bottom of Tiger News.
 - We will have two Open House sessions to decrease the number of families in the school at one time.
 - 6:00-6:30 pm Families with last names beginning with A-M.
 - 6:30-7:00 pm Families with last names beginning with N-Z
- **School Team Meetings** Some families will be meeting with the school team in October to set up individualized learning plans for their child. These meetings will take place throughout the month of October.

- Consent forms Signed consent packages are due at the office. This year there will be a community consent permission form, which will allow students to go on walking field trips within the Taylor community. This form will be kept on file and will be current for this school year. Teachers will inform families of a walking field trip at least one day prior via email. Paper permission form must be returned to the school for all other field trips, verbal consent will not be accepted.
- Allergy alerts will be specific to each classroom and the types of allergies in each classroom will be shared in a confidential manner by each teacher to their families. We are not a peanut free school and will continue with our daily hand hygiene practices and no food sharing policy to keep students safe. - **Taylor School Routines and Processes** We are working on a slideshow for families that will be shared out next week with all our school routines and processes. As we settle into the school year, we will continue to update and share with families. A few routines have been listed below:
 - Morning and after school supervision Students can be dropped off no earlier than 8:30 am and there is no after school supervision with the
 exception of late bus students. Students are welcome to stay on the playground after school with parent supervision.
 - Visitors are welcome, but all visitors must check in at the office and wear a mask.
 - We will be asking families and community visitors to enter via the playground doors and district staff to enter via the parking lot door. The visitor sign-in will be at the office. All visitors have to sign in at the office.
 - End of the day student pick-up will be outside.
 - Appointments will need to be made to set up meetings with teachers or the principal. Please call the school or email to set up meetings.
 - Please send a lunch that does not need to be heated, microwaves will not be available in classrooms for student use, due to Health and Safety guidelines.
