

- Popcorn Dates to remember. Ordering for both will be online with taylor.hotlunches.net. Popcorn order opens on Nov 12-18. Popcorn day is Nov 19.
- Hot Lunch/Milk orders for Dec opens Nov 15-29. You can send cash or cheque to the school or use the e-transfer taypayments@prn.bc.ca. Please when sending an e transfer to the school at any time add to the message who and what it is for. This will help me attach the payment to the correct student. If you are receiving an "add password message" STOP and do not send. We are set up for direct deposit. Please contact the school for any questions. Thank you!
- It's Winter! Although we don't have snow, the temperatures are dropping. Please send your children with winter gear, as students will be outside most days. - **RETAKES and ORDERING** Those who had retakes done last week will be bringing home their photo tickets. Please use this to access your photos online. With retakes being ready, the photographer has activated the FREE SHIPPING window for all Taylor school orders for between now and November 13th at noon. All orders between these dates will be shipped together to the school. All orders after that will have a small shipping charge added to the order, and will be sent directly to the address you use when placing your order.
 - **Previous Photo Orders** If you placed an order during the first free shipping window, that order should be arriving soon. If you ordered after the free shipping window, please watch for that in the mail.
- Volleyball Practices are Tuesday and Thursday at lunch. The next game will be a home game against Duncan Cran. There will be inter-school elementary volleyball league games but at this time there will be no spectators due to health and safety guidelines. Students can be picked up outside after the games. Parents may choose to pick up their child at the away games, but will need to pick up outside the school and let the coach know. Students will return to their home school on the bus if not picked up.

- Communication from Superintendent regarding the New Provincial K-3 Masking mandate:
 - Dear Parents,
 - The provincial health officer along with the Ministry of Education announced a change to mask requirements in K-12 schools. Effective Monday, October 4th, mandatory face masks will now be extended to include students in K-3 in school and on buses. Further information on the update can be found here.. We ask that you send your K-3 child with the appropriately-sized mask next week but we understand that it may take some time to procure them. The School District is also working on sourcing a supply. All children will be welcomed regardless of whether or not they are wearing a mask. As with the other grades, it is also possible to request an exemption. Schools remain one of the safest environments during this pandemic and it is critical that education continues uninterrupted for students and families. Thank you for your understanding as we continue to work through this pandemic together.
- COVID-19 Exposure Notification Process The notification process has recently changed. In the event of a potential school exposure, Northern Health will be posting information on their website at https://www.northernhealth.ca/health-topics/public-exposures-and-outbreaks#covid-19-school-exposures General letters to the entire school will be replaced by the website notifications similar to what occurred during winter and spring breaks last year. Letters may be sent home to select close contacts as determined by Northern Health. For example a letter may be sent to a specific classroom and the notice posted on the NH website.
