RE: IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR UPCOMING MEETING ON Wednesday, March 1, 2023 at 6:30pm

This notice is to let you know that we will be holding a parent information meeting regarding the upcoming ski trip planned for Wednesday, March 8 to Whispering Pines Ski Hill in Worsley, Alberta.

Because this is deemed a high risk activity every student (even previous participants) *must have one parent in attendance* at the information session on Wednesday, March 1, 2022 at 6:30pm. This is School District #60 Policy. This meeting will be available through Zoom also. Parents will have to sign in with their name or their child's name. This is recorded for attendance. The email from the school will be sent out prior to the evening meeting.

This meeting will be held in Mrs. McDonell's classroom. It is not essential that your child attend the meeting as they will be receiving the same information at school prior to the trip and it is expected that parents have conversations with their children about the trip.

At the meeting you will receive information about the trip, hear how to best prepare your child for this type of outing, be informed about ski hill safety, be given or hand in the Worsley paperwork, and be able to ask questions.

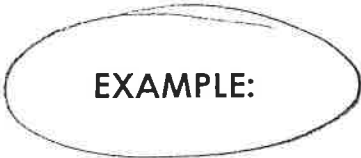
Parents Needed! We are not able to go without parent support. We will need 2 parent chaperones per classroom and these people must have a criminal record check.

- We need parents on the hill and in the chalet.
- Only students grade 3-6 and parents from TES are able to ride the bus but we definitely encourage whole families with younger or older children to participate by driving themselves, too.
- Students can be driven to the hill but ONLY by their parent/guardian – not Aunty, cousin, best friend, babysitter etc.
- We ask that all family members sign up through the school to keep everything organized and keep down costs. These members will also get the group rate. We have discovered that getting our equipment takes longer if the lineup is held up by separate payments and paperwork.

*If finances are a concern please feel free to confidentially contact Mrs. McDonell. We would like everyone to enjoy this experience.

I waive any and all claims I may have against and release from all liability and agree not to sue the Board of Trustees of School District No. 60 and its officers, employees, agents, volunteers and representatives, and the Ministry of Education for any personal injury, death, property damage or loss sustained as a result of my child's participation in the field trip, arising out of any cause whatsoever, including negligence.

Students from 4 classes (approximately 75) will be going to Whispering Pines Ski Hill located near Worsley, Alberta, which is 25 km northwest of Worsley and will be away from school from 7:15 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. They will be traveling by school bus (approximately 150 km from Fort St. John).

Any student causing a major infraction of school expectations will have a parent called to come and pick him/her up, or be charged the cost of gas to be brought home early. Students must have their school work up to date and show responsible behaviour to go on the trip. Parents will be volunteering from each class. Parents will be on the hill with the students in addition to having parents from each class in the chalet. We will have one teacher driving her own vehicle as our emergency vehicle.

- If a student is sent home from Worsley because of behaviour, money will not be reimbursed.

TO: Worsley Clear Hills Ski Club operated as Whispering Pines Ski Area and its directors, officers, employees, instructors, agents, representatives, volunteers, independent contractors, subcontractors, sponsors, successors and assigns (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Releasees").

ASSUMPTION OF RISKS

I am aware that skiing, snowboarding and participating in snow school lessons, clinics and sessions involve many risks, dangers and hazards including, but not limited to: boarding, riding and disembarking ski lifts; changing weather conditions; avalanches; exposed rock, earth, ice, and other natural objects; trees, tree wells, tree stumps and forest deadfall; the condition of snow or ice on or beneath the surface; variations in the terrain which may create blind spots or areas of reduced visibility; variations in the surface or sub-surface, including changes due to man-made or artificial snow; variable and difficult conditions; streams, creeks, and exposed holes in the snow pack above streams or creeks; cliffs; crevasses; snow cat roads, road-banks or cut-banks; collision with lift towers, fences, snow making equipment, snow grooming equipment, snow cats, snowmobiles or other vehicles, equipment or structures; encounters with domestic and wild animals including dogs and bears; collision with other persons; loss of balance or control; slips, trips and falls; accidents during snow school lessons; infectious disease contracted through viruses, bacteria, parasites, and fungi which may be transmitted through direct or indirect contact; negligent first aid; failure to act safely or within one's own ability or to stay within designated areas; negligence of other persons; and **NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES. I UNDERSTAND THAT NEGLIGENCE INCLUDES FAILURE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES TO TAKE REASONABLE STEPS TO SAFEGUARD OR PROTECT ME FROM OR WARN ME OF THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS REFERRED TO ABOVE.** I am also aware that the risks, dangers and hazards referred to above exist throughout and beyond the ski area and that many hazards are unmarked. **I FREELY ACCEPT AND FULLY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS AND THE POSSIBILITY OF PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE OR LOSS RESULTING THEREFROM.**

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT. I hereby agree as follows:

- 1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I have or may in the future have against THE RELEASEES, and TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any loss, damage, expense or injury including death that I may suffer, or that my next of kin may suffer, as a result of my use of or my presence on the premises or travel beyond the ski area boundary DUE TO ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR BREACH OF ANY STATUTORY OR OTHER DUTY OF CARE, INCLUDING ANY DUTY OF CARE OWED UNDER THE OCCUPIERS' LIABILITY ACT, RSA 2000, c O-4, ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES. I UNDERSTAND THAT NEGLIGENCE INCLUDES THE FAILURE ON PART OF THE RELEASEES TO TAKE REASONABLE STEPS TO SAFEGUARD OR PROTECT ME FROM OR WARN ME OF THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS REFERRED TO ABOVE.**
2. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES for any and all liability for any damage to the property of or personal injury to any third party, resulting from my use of or presence on the premises or travel beyond the ski area boundary;

ASSUMPTION OF RISKS

I am aware that skiing, snowboarding and snowshoeing involve risks, dangers and hazards and that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence in these sports.

ALPINE SKIING I understand that the ski boot/binding system may not release during every fall or may release unexpectedly. The ski boot/binding system is no guarantee that the user will not be injured.

SNOWBOARDING/ SNOWSHOEING I understand that the boot/binding system is not designed or intended to release and will not release under normal circumstances. I understand that as the boot/binding system is a non-release system, this system will not reduce the risk of injury during a fall and will increase the risk of not surviving an avalanche.

HELMETS I understand that a helmet designed for recreational snow sports may reduce the risk of some types of head injuries. I recognize that serious head injury can occur even when a helmet is worn.
