

- Welcome to our new Kindergarten students and families!

 - Wednesday, September 27th @ Upper Pine @ 1:00 pm Students will be transported by bus and will leave the school by 11:50 am.
 - Wednesday, October 4th @ Lone Wolf Golf Course @ 1:00 pm Students will walk to the race @ 12:15 pm and will walk back to the school.
 - Soccer Mrs. McDonell will be coaching Soccer and practices will be posted in Tiger News and on DOJO. There is no league play for Soccer.
 The tournament is on Saturday, October 7th.
- Consent packages A package of consent forms along with the school fee invoices will come home on Monday, Sept. 11th. Please complete all forms and return as soon as possible. If you have any questions about the forms please call the office or email the school. Included is a community consent form. This allows classes to go on walking field trips within the Taylor community throughout the school year.
- Before and After School Supervision If families need before and after school care please see the BASC information below.
 - o Morning supervision begins @ 8:30 am with the exception of early bus students
 - There is no after school supervision, with the exception of late bus students.
 - Students need to head home after school but are welcome to stay with parent supervision
 - When checking out your child early, please call the office or stop by the office. The office will page your child down to the office or we can send them out to you.
 - We ask families to wait outside for their child/children at 2:45 pm dismissal. This ensures a smooth dismissal process.
 - $\circ\quad$ Families are welcome to join students on the playground at the end of the day.
- School Fees/Charges can be paid via MYED or taypayments as well as by cheque.\
 - Online Payment for school fees via MYED This is a secure platform to pay for your child's school fees. Payments can be made using Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Visa Debit and Mastercard Debit.

- **Breakfast Program** This program is for early bus students and other students that do not eat breakfast at home. This program is funded via community donations and the Ministry's "Feeding Futures" fund. A consent form needs to be signed to participate in Breakfast Program. - School supplies are purchased by the school and the included in the yearly school charges.

 - Each student will need a pair of indoor shoes.
- Allergy alerts will be specific to each classroom and the types of allergies in each classroom will be shared in a confidential manner by each teacher to their families. We are not a peanut free school and will continue with our daily hand hygiene practices and no food sharing policy to keep students safe. As well, for students with severe allergies or other medical concerns all staff have access to student medical safety posters.  - An allergy allert poster will also be posted in the classroom for any visitors to the school.
- Lunches Please send lunches that do not need reheating, there is no access to microwaves or hot water for lunches. Hot lunch and milk will not start until October sometime.
