

- Winter Reading Challenge will begin on Tuesday, December 16th. The information package and reading log sheets were sent home last week.
 - "Slide into Reading!" Reading Challenge The wonderful students at Taylor Elementary School are challenged to read at home for four weeks to earn points for their class. The reading challenge will begin on Tuesday, January 16, 2024 and will end on Thursday, February 15, 2024.
 - Each day that a student reads at home, he/she needs to fill in the amount of time spent reading that day on their weekly calendar. A parent or guardian must sign the weekly total to verify that the reading record is accurate. At the beginning of each week, on Tuesdays, the weekly calendars will be collected and the points will be added to the class's weekly total.
 - There is a large sliding hill on the wall in the hallway outside the library. Each class has a sled and the points earned by each student will help their class's sled to slide further down the hill.
 - Kindergarten to Grade 2 students may count the time that they are read to and are encouraged to read at least 20 minutes per week.
 - Grades 3, 4, 5 and 6 students are encouraged to read at least 30 minutes per week.
 - THREE WAYS TO WIN PRIZES:
 - PRIZE FOR THE TOP TWO READERS IN EACH CLASS: The two students in each class who have the highest total number of reading minutes will win a prize.
 - PARTICIPATION DRAWS IN EACH CLASS: Every student who participates in the reading challenge will be entered into a draw to win prizes. There will be two participation prizes awarded by random draw for each class per week.
 - PRIZE FOR THE CLASS WITH THE MOST MINUTES READ: The class with the most reading minutes will win a prize.
 - All students who participate in the reading challenge will receive a certificate recognizing their efforts and achievements.

 - We do not have a temperature cut-off for inside days, we look at the ambient temperature, wind chill and the amount of time that students will be outside.
 - We assess this throughout the school day and try to get students outside even on colder days for short amounts of time. Whenever possible we want students
 to get fresh air throughout the day.
